Teams

Spectators are expected to show good sportsmanship at all times to officials, players, coaches, game workers and other spectators. Parking

- Xavier plays their Flag Football games on **Petznick field** located on the Xavier campus (see attached map).
 - o Guests will enter Xavier from 7th St. and Highland (traffic light)
 - o There is a guard station on the south side when you enter the school.
 - o Immediately turn left just past the guard station and head east to the back of the school. Parking will be available behind Founders Hall.
 - o Guests will then walk west along the back side of Founders Hall, which will take them to the field.
 - <u>Do not park on Meadowbrook Ave</u>. This is permit parking and cars maybe ticketed/towed.
 - Spectators can park in any open space after 2:35pm.
- Gates to our venues open 1 hour prior to the event start time.

Admission will be charged. All tickets can be bought on **GoFan.co**Enter Xavier College Prep, open Flag Football and select the best option for you and your family. Most opposing schools use GoFan for ticketing

General Information

- Clear bag policy will be in effect. No large purses, backpacks, coolers, etc.
- Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time, including after the game.
- Snack bar. A snack bar may be open on game days. If open cash only is accepted
- Restrooms are located in the McGroder building to the west of the field and can be accessed from the bleachers.

For the safety and security of our guests, the following are not prohibited on the Xavier Campus. Inappropriate behavior includes, but is not limited to, the follow:

- No animals, except working service animals. Emotional support animals are not allowed. Documentation must be provided.
- Creating any safety hazard.
- Throwing, tossing or discharging any object or liquid substance.
- Using profanity and /or other offensive language.
- Taunting or using offensive language against umpires, teams, coaches, or facility staff.
- Disturbing other guests' enjoyment of the event.
- Use of alcohol or using offensive language against, umpires, teams, coaches or facility staff.
- Tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco.
- Drunk and disorderly conduct.
- Fighting or challenging others to fight.
- Bikes, skateboards, scooters, hover boards, long boards.
- Sticks, poles or similar objects that can be used as a weapon.
- Fireworks, drones or laser
