Parking

- Xavier plays their Soccer games on **Petznick field** located on the Xavier campus (see attached map).
 - \circ Guests will enter Xavier from 7th St. and Highland (traffic light). Park in the school parking lot
 - o Do not park on Meadowbrook Ave.
- Gates to our venues open 1 hour prior to the event start time.

General Information

- Clear bag policy will be in effect. No large purses, backpacks, coolers, etc.
- Spectators are not allowed on the playing field at any time, including after the game.
- Snack bar. A snack bar may be open on game days. If open cash only is accepted
- Restrooms are located in the McGroder building to the west of the field and can be accessed from the bleachers.
- Spectators are asked to meet their daughter outside the facility next to Founders Hall and the Chapel.

For the safety and security of our guests, the following are not prohibited on the Xavier Campus. Inappropriate behavior includes, but is not limited to, the follow:

- No animals, except working service animals. Emotional support animals are not allowed. Documentation must be provided.
- Creating any safety hazard.
- Throwing, tossing or discharging any object or liquid substance.
- Using profanity and /or other offensive language.

- Taunting or using offensive language against umpires, teams, coaches, or facility staff.
- Disturbing other guests' enjoyment of the event.
- Use of alcohol or using offensive language against, umpires, teams, coaches or facility staff.
- Tobacco products, including e-cigarettes and smokeless cigarettes/tobacco.
- Drunk and disorderly conduct.
- Fighting or challenging others to fight.
- Bikes, skateboards, scooters, hoverboards, longboards.
- Sticks, poles or similar objects that can be used as a weapon.
- Fireworks, drones or laser
